

小・中学校 警報等の発表時における安全確保について (令和8年6月版)

Safety measures for elementary and junior high schools when warning announcements or other alerts are issued. (June 2026)

四日市市教育委員会

This document outlines the basic responses for elementary and junior high schools when warnings or advisories are issued where each school should prioritize the safety of its students and make decisions based on the specific circumstances of their school and community. The warnings and alerts covered by this standard are as follows: 暴風警報 Storm warning、暴風雪警報 Snow storm warning、緊急地震速報 Earthquake early warning、津波警報 Tsunami warning、大津波警報 Big tsunami warning、**レベル5大雨特別警報 Level 5 Heavy Rain Emergency Warning**、**レベル4大雨危険警報 Level 4 Heavy Rain Risk Warnings**、竜巻注意情報 Tornado warning、雷注意情報 Thunderstorm warning、洪水警報 Flood warning、土砂災害警報 Landslide warning、記録的短時間大雨情報 Record-breaking short-period heavy rain information、南海トラフ臨時情報 Nankai Trough Earthquake Special Information、熱中症特別警戒アラート Heatstroke and special warning alert, and others.

1 What to do when a 暴風警報 Storm warning・暴風雪警報 Snow storm warning・大雪警報 Heavy snow is issued・**レベル4大雨危険警報 Level 4 Heavy Rain Risk Warnings**

【While the warning is currently being announced】

- Until 7:00 am : Students should stay at home.
- After arriving at school : The school will assess the situation and implement necessary safety measures.

【When the warning is released】

- When the warning is lifted by 7:00 AM: The school will resume as usual.
- When the warning is lifted after 7:00 AM: The school will be temporarily closed

※ Even after a heavy snow warning has been lifted, it may still be difficult for students to get to school depending on the snow conditions. Therefore, if snow accumulation is confirmed to be approximately 20 cm or more, schools will decide to close temporarily.

2 What to do when 特別警報 Special warnings (Level 5 Heavy Rain, Storm, level 5 Storm surge, Level 5 River Inundation, Level 5 Landslide, High waves, Snow storm, Heavy snow), Big tsunami warnings or Earthquakes of intensity 5 or higher is issued

【Before going to school】

- The school will be temporarily closed.
- Follow the instructions of the city and related organizations and take action to protect your life.

【After arriving at school】

- Standby at school
- Evacuate to a safe place immediately and hand over to a guardian if necessary.

※ After the warning is lifted, safety will be confirmed and students will resume commuting to and from school; however, the principal may decide to close the school temporarily.

【When an earthquake of magnitude 5 or higher occurs】

The school will ensure the safety of the students and provide them with protection until their parents are able to pick them up.

【In the case of a tsunami or big tsunami warning】

Students will be evacuated to a safe, elevated location such as the 3rd floor or higher of the school building, and will, in principle, remain at the school until their parents pick them up.

3 What to do when a record-breaking short-period heavy rainfall warning is issued.

In Mie Prefecture, when a short-period extremely heavy rainfall which occurs only once every few years is observed while a heavy rain warning is in effect, a 「Record-Breaking Short-Term Heavy Rainfall Information」 warning will be issued.

【Before going to school】

If a 「Record-breaking short-term heavy rainfall warning」 is issued at 7:00 AM : Students should stay at home.

→ After that, necessary measures such as 「臨時休校 Temporary school closures」 or 「始業時間の繰り下げ Postponement of the start time of school」 will be taken.

【After arriving at school】

If a 「Record-breaking short-term heavy rainfall warning」 is issued after students have arrived at school: Standby at school.

→ Evacuate to a safe place immediately.

4 Club activities when a level 3 heavy rain warning is issued.

【Weekends and holidays】

If a 「level 3 Heavy rain warning」 is issued at 7:00 AM : As a rule, club activities will be canceled.

【Morning practice】

If a 「level 3 Heavy rain warning」 is issued at 6:00 AM: Morning practice will be canceled.

5 What to do when a Heatstroke special warning alert (Heatstroke special warning information) is issued.

If a Heatstroke special warning is issued in Mie Prefecture : Temporary school closures will be implemented.

※ Notification of temporary school closures will be sent by the Board of Education via the Yokkaichi City School Parent Communication System (Home&School).

6 What to do when in the event of a ballistic missile attack

- If an emergency information such as a J-Alert is issued before going to school: Stay at home.
- If an emergency information is issued while you are at school: Evacuate to a safe place immediately.
- If a ballistic missile lands in the city or a neighboring town : The school will be closed temporarily.

7 What to do in the event of a Nankai Trough Earthquake Emergency Information (調査中 Under monitoring) being issued.

The following actions (1) ~ (3) will be taken based on the results of the investigation.

(1) A 「巨大地震警戒 Big earthquake warning」 has been issued.

All public elementary and junior high schools in the city will be temporarily closed for one week.

- During this period, schools will be opened as evacuation shelters. (Excluding schools located in areas prone to flooding.)

(2) A 「巨大地震注意 Big earthquake advisory」 has been issued.

- School activities will continue with caution. But there may be cases where students are sent home early or schools are closed..

- (3) 『調査終了 Monitoring finished』 is announced.
- Regular school activities will be continued.
